- Connecting food trucks and stalls to generators or on-site power
- Ensuring correct cabling, load safety, and compliance with food truck legislation
- Identifying and flagging non-compliant vendors when needed
- Assisting with heavy lifting and setup of power gear and site infrastructure

You'll Need:

- Experience with event power, generators, caravan sockets, etc.
- A solid understanding of food truck and mobile trading legislation (or willingness to learn)
- Physical ability to lift/carry up to 15kgs
- A proactive, safety-first mindset
- To be reliable, punctual, and good under pressure
- A friendly yet proactive demeanour

Bonus If You:

Have worked with food vendors or at other markets/events
Know your way around three-phase, single-phase, and caravan plugs

This is a paid, contract role. One market at a time.

There may be an opportunity to increase hours as the markets scale.



Hours of Work:
